

## **Educational Visit to KTH Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm**

From June 7th to 9th within the framework of the Erasmus+ BOOST program in KTH Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm, the first educational-academic visit took place.

23 participants from the higher education institutions paid a visit to it, including those of Sweden, Spain, Portugal, Estonia, and the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture, and Sport of RA, and the National Informational Centre of Academic Mutual Recognition and Mobility.

The aim was to explore the experience and tactics of globalisation presented by the European partners as well as to discuss and arrange the program's further actions.

During the three-day meeting, participants from Armenia got acquainted with and studied the information on the structure of international departments of higher educational institutions, currently available international programmes, execution of exchange programmes and the process of globalisation, as well as about the process of refining a globalisation strategy presented not only by the programme's European partners but also by the professors invited from Swedish and other universities.

Armenian partners of the programme represented the structure of the newly-created website and its contents. Also, the participants of the Erasmus+ HARMONY programme refined a toolset for globalising the universities in the Republic of Armenia and introduced the results of the previously carried out research.
