

BOOST Inter-coaching Training

On May 25, 2017, Inter-coaching training took place in Armenian State Pedagogical University with the participation of HARMONY programme representatives. Possible frameworks of the cooperation between the two programmes were presented.

The HARMONY programme has been running for 1.5 years. According to the work packages, the following activities have been performed:

1. The experience of internationalization of the partner universities of the programme has been studied.
2. Two questionnaires have been developed to reveal the level of internationalization of higher-educational institutions (HEIs). One of the questionnaires, the internal one, has been tested only among the HEIs participating in the programme, and the external one, for the universities of participating states. The questionnaires provide an opportunity to consider the indicators needed by HEIs for internationalization.
3. The analysis of the questionnaires has been presented. Armenian HEIs need to pay attention to the budgetary allocations of the Ministry and the HEI to boost the internationalization process (it is stated in the questionnaires how much the total budget of the HEI is, how much the amount of money received from the external programmes is, and what its percentage in the total budget is; allocations are calculated in the same way).

Programme coordinator and participating HEIs are ready to provide their work done within the framework of the programme, cooperate with BOOST programme participants, acquire and use the developing packages planned by BOOST programme, as well as carry out joint activities.
